

Swimming Lesson and Sporting Carnivals Consent

Throughout the year, students will be doing class activities and PE lessons that will include athletics and swimming and they may also participate in carnivals such as Swimming, Cross Country and Athletics and Interschool and Regional carnivals.

The inherent risk level associated with participating in activities within these carnivals are medium to high, indicating there is some chance of an incident and injury requiring first aid. It is imperative that students protect themselves by wearing enclosed footwear for athletics events and appropriate clothing and sun protective at all other times.

Consent

After reading the information above in relation to these carnivals I am aware that the Department of Education does not have personal accident insurance cover for students. If your child participates in these carnivals it is understood that they have parental permission to participate and the following guidelines have been acknowledged.

- I give consent for my child to participate in the activities listed above.
- In the event of an accident or illness, I authorise school staff to obtain or administer any medical assistance or treatment my child may reasonably require, including contacting my child's doctor.
- I have provided the school all relevant details relating to my child's medical or physical needs on enrolment and where relevant have updated this information.
- I accept liability for all costs incurred in obtaining such medical assistance or treatment (including any transportation costs) and undertake to reimburse the State of Queensland (via the Department of Education) the full amount of any costs incurred on my child's behalf.

I give permission for my child, _____ to participate in the school athletics, cross country, swimming lessons and carnival and sporting events and travel by bus when needed. Students will be transported to and from the Normanton Swimming Pool for swimming lessons in the school bus.

Normanton Swimming Pool:

Swimming Lessons – Monday – Friday – Term 1 and Term 4 2024 (Students travel on the school bus)

Swimming Carnival - 27th November 2024 (8.30am – 2.30pm) Students travel to and from via their own transport.

John Henry Memorial Oval:

Normanton State School Athletics Carnival – 11th & 12th July 2024. (8.30am – 2.30pm) Students will find their own transport to and from the John Henry Memorial Oval for the Athletics Carnival.

Normanton Golf Club:

Cross Country – 19th April 2024 (8.30am – 2.30pm) Students will find their own way to the Golf Club for the Cross Country, but will return to school on the school bus.
